

## What is The Illuminating Engineering Society (IES) Award?

The Illuminating Engineering Society (IES) Award (offered jointly with founding scholarship partners Canlyte and Osram Sylvania) was established by the Illuminating Engineering Society of North America (IESNA), Toronto Section. The award recognizes the academic achievement and provides financial assistance to Chang School continuing education students registered in the Certificate in Lighting Design.

## What is the value of The Illuminating Engineering Society (IES) Award?

There are two annual awards valued at \$1,000 each.

## Who is eligible to apply?

To be eligible to apply for The Illuminating Engineering Society (IES) Award you must meet all of the following criteria:

1. Be a Chang School continuing education student registered in the Certificate in Lighting Design
2. Have successfully completed a minimum of three courses in the Certificate in Lighting Design
3. Have maintained a minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 3.0 (B)
4. Be a Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident, or Protected Person (with valid *PPSD*)
5. Be an Ontario resident for at least one year (12 consecutive months)
6. Have demonstrated financial need (see Application, Part 4)

## Who is ineligible to apply?

You are ineligible to apply if you have received the award in the past.

## How will students be selected?

Students will be evaluated and ranked according to the following criteria:

1. Evidence of academic achievement (*Unofficial Transcript*)
2. Essay (250 words or more) outlining your academic and career goals and the impact that receiving this award would have on your future
3. Preference will be given to students employed full-time or part-time in the lighting industry

Students are expected to be honest in providing information on the application and in any subsequent discussions. If there is clear evidence that a student has misrepresented their circumstances or achievements, the award will be refused or withdrawn.

## Application and Notification

The Illuminating Engineering Society (IES) Award application is available online on The Chang School website and at The G. Raymond Chang School of Continuing Education, Heaslip House, 297 Victoria Street. Your completed application must be printed and handed in at the information desk in The Chang School lobby by **4:00 p.m. on Friday, August 18, 2017**.

All students will be notified by email. The successful students will have their name posted on The Chang School website and a formal presentation of this award will be made at The Chang School Awards ceremony in Fall 2017.
