

What is The G. Raymond Chang Award?

The G. Raymond Chang award was created by Brigette Chang-Addorisio and Andrew Chang, the daughter and son of the late G. Raymond Chang, Ryerson University's third Chancellor and patron of The G. Raymond Chang School of Continuing Education at Ryerson University. The award reflects the importance that Raymond Chang placed on access to post-secondary education for working adults. The award will provide financial support to a continuing education student who has successfully completed 75% of a certificate or part-time degree program and has maintained a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 (B).

What is the value of The G. Raymond Chang Award?

There is one annual award valued at \$3,000.

Who is eligible to apply?

To be eligible to apply for The G. Raymond Chang Award you must meet all of the following criteria:

1. Be a Continuing education student who has successfully completed 75% of a certificate or part-time degree program
2. Have maintained a minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 3.0 (B)
3. Be a Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident, or Protected Person
4. Be an Ontario resident for at least one year (12 consecutive months)
5. Have demonstrated financial need (see Application, Part 4)

Who is ineligible to apply?

You are ineligible to apply if you have received the award in the past.

How will students be selected?

Students will be evaluated and ranked according to the following criteria:

1. Evidence of academic achievement (*Unofficial Transcript*)
2. Essay (approximately 250 words) outlining your life and/or career aspirations and how this award would help you to achieve your goals

Students are expected to be honest in providing information on the application and in any subsequent discussions. If there is clear evidence that a student has misrepresented their circumstances or achievements, the award will be refused or withdrawn.

Application and Notification

The G. Raymond Chang Award application is available online on The Chang School website and at The Chang School, Heaslip House, 297 Victoria Street. Your completed application must be printed and handed in at the information desk in The Chang School lobby by **4:00 p.m. on Friday, August 18, 2017**.

All students will be notified by email. The successful student will have their name posted on The Chang School website and a formal presentation of this award will be made at The Chang School Awards ceremony in Fall 2017.
